That's why now is the perfect moment to give your awning a little attention, keeping it in great condition, so that you can continue enjoying it well into the autumn.

An awning isn't just for the peak of summer — it's a feature that can extend outdoor living through every season. With a little maintenance and preparation, it can continue to transform your garden into a space that's welcoming, practical, and enjoyable all year round.



OUR AWNING SERVICE OFFER

Whether you are keen to continue using your awning throughout the winter, or would prefer to reduce use until we see the warmer weather in Spring, we recommend booking an annual service to ensure your awning stands the test of time.

Our awning service includes a 14 point check:

1. Re-align the fabric.
2. Check and adjust the front rail height if required.
3. Inspect all fixings to ensure they are secure.
4. Brush down the fabric to remove loose dirt or dry bird droppings.
5. Clean hardware components.
6. Check the functionality of the handset or wall switch.
7. Verify motor limits.
8. Lubricate all moving parts with grease or oil.
9. Repair and report on any findings.
10. Re-align and re-tension arms as necessary.
11. Remove or refit the valance depending on the season.
12. Winterisation of the awning (remove valance and check seals).
13. Inspect sensors and reprogram if necessary.
14. Test lights and heaters (if applicable).
